As part of his Eagle Scout Project, Kyle Wilkinson, a senior at Walled Lake Northern, constructed three Little Free Pantries to be placed outside of Wixom, Walled Lake and Mary Helen Guest elementary schools in the Walled Lake Consolidated School District. Linda McLean, a former board member with the Pantry and a valued volunteer, helped to coordinate this on behalf of the Pantry. Wilkinson and his family have been volunteers at the Pantry's annual Santa Shop for several years. The Little Free Pantries will hold food items such as canned and boxed food. It is Wilkinson's hope that the community will replenish the supplies as needed, but Donovan Neal, executive director of Hospitality House, says they will make sure they're never empty. 
